ACCEPT BRAD CALBO’S RESIGNATION

Present were Ted Larson, attorney for the Commissioners regarding the Brad Calbo case, and Sam Beus, Acting Jerome County prosecutor.

Commissioner Crouch announced that the Board was in receipt of a written agreement signed by Prosecutor Brad Calbo and a resignation letter that was not signed by him.

Ted Larson said Calbo’s attorney had authorized him to write Calbo’s signature as “/s/Brad Calbo” on the resignation letter. Larson further informed the Board that Calbo had made no changes to the agreement that he had signed as submitted by the Board of Commissioners.

❖ A Motion was made by Commissioner Howell to accept the resignation of Brad Calbo and to sign the agreement and general release. It was seconded and carried with unanimous ayes.

Commissioner Crouch said Calbo’s resignation was effective August 31, 2023.

Commissioner Howell asked if the agreement was public information, and Larson replied that it was. He said that the agreement called for no disparagement between the County and Calbo.

➤ Sam Beus asked that the Board apprise his office of efforts to appoint a successor to Calbo so there could be some finality to the resignation.
